Medical Action Myanmar (MAM) is a medical aid organization, whose mission it is to improve access to quality health care in Myanmar. MAM aims to provide large-scale access to prevention, diagnosis & treatment of malaria, Basic Health Care (BHC) and tuberculosis. We support a large number of Village Health Workers (VHW) who are volunteers trained in rapid diagnostic testing and supplied with diagnostics and treatments. A basic health care package is provided to deal with the most common BHC diseases, including a referral system for complicated cases. Furthermore a TB Active Case Finding component is offered including screening and referrals of suspected TB cases and treatment follow-up of confirmed TB cases.

Description of the vacant position;

Main responsibility

The **Medical Doctor/Team leader** is the leader of the MAM project field team responsible for the set up and maintenance of a well good functioning VHW network in the project area in line the MAM strategy for VHW activities. The project field team consists of the Medical Doctor Team leader and local staff who facilitate monitoring and support activities to VHW.

Key Objectives and Responsibilities in general;

Operational management:

- To explore remote medical underserved areas for potential villages benefitting from VHW activities;
- To select, train and set up new VHW;
- To manage the planning of the monthly monitoring of the VHW activities;
- To analyze activities and make relevant action plans;
- To represent the project on a local level in relation to other stakeholders;
- To prepare the monthly project reports in a defined time frame;
- To advise the project (medical) coordinator concerning project implementation in relation to practical field reality;

Human resources management:

- To lead and supervise one or more a monitoring field teams of locally recruited staff;
- To use capacity of staff to the maximum benefit of the project;
- To perform briefings, performance discussions and debriefings of the field team(s);
- To perform capacity building and training sessions for field staff.

Requirements
